

## **Suggested Forms of Bequests**

When making or revising a will, a donor should obtain the assistance of an attorney. Members of the Stillwater Medical Foundation office will be pleased to work with you and your attorney to design an estate plan specifically tailored to your wishes. The following are suggested forms for making various types of bequests:

1.	Outright Bequest in Will (unrestricted)	
	a. 9	Specific dollar amount:

	d. Share of, or entire residue of estate:

2.	Conditional Bequest in Will:

3.	Restricted Use:
