**Statement on the Impact of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)
on the Stillwater Medical Foundation's High School Fellowship Program**

As you might expect, it is hard to make plans several months in advance as we continue to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic. The Stillwater Medical Foundation is moving forward with the hope that this summer's program will take place. However, no guarantee is given or implied.

Possible impacts to the 2021 Fellowship Program:

Application Timeline

The application for the 2021 High School Fellowships will open on March 1 and close on April 5. The Stillwater Medical Foundation reserves the right to amend the closing date.

Program Length

The fellowship program lasts six weeks (30 working days). There is not a specific start and end date, as we work with individual fellows to determine the dates of their program. It is possible that a delay or cancellation may occur at any time, from the determination of the awards to the conclusion of the shadowing opportunities.

Such delay or cancellation may make successful completion of a fellow's program impossible, as the ability to make up days may be limited.

Program Content

Even if there are no delays or cancellations during the program, opportunities for shadowing or observation may be limited. Additionally, field trips that are normally part of the fellowships may not be available due to visitation restrictions.

Communication During Application Process

Once a student has submitted their application form, Foundation staff will keep them informed of any changes to the application timeline.
