Personal Statement

Use the Personal Statement as an opportunity to distinguish yourself from other applicants. Consider and write your essay carefully.

Here are some questions to consider while writing the essay: 1) Why are you interested in the field of medicine for your future career, and 2) What motivates you to learn more about medicine?

The essay is limited to one page in length, single space, 12 pt type in a Times Roman style font.

Statement construction, spelling, and grammar are important. Consider having someone review your statement before uploading the document.
